The Louisiana Legislative Auditor performs an annual single audit of the basic financial statements and the major federal award programs for the State of Louisiana. The audit of the basic financial statements is conducted in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States. The audit of major federal award programs complies with the Single Audit Act as amended in 1996 and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Uniform Guidance. The single audit covers the state's basic financial statements, Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards, internal controls, and compliance. An audit report on the basic financial statements is included in the 2017 *Comprehensive Annual Financial Report* (CAFR). Audit reports on the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards, internal controls and compliance are included in the 2017 Single Audit Report.

These reports meet the requirements of the Single Audit Act and OMB Uniform Guidance for each state agency and university. No additional single audit or report is required of each state agency or university, even if the agency's or university's federal award programs were not specifically reviewed during the audit year.

The audit of Louisiana State University (LSU) and A&M College is included in the 2017 Single Audit Report for the State of Louisiana. This report did not include any audit findings related to the financial statements, however, there were five findings directly related to the administration of federal awards by the LSU and A&M College for sponsored programs.
