



TIGER TRANSITION TEAM (T3) PEER MENTOR POSITION DESCRIPTION

General Requirements & Expectations

General Requirements:

1. Must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 hrs.) at LSU during the academic year;
2. Must be in good academic standing with the University, have at least a 2.0 semester & cumulative GPA, preferably a 2.5 GPA; and
3. Must not be on academic probation, disciplinary probation with restrictions, or deferred suspension.
4. Must be available to serve as a mentor for the entire Fall Semester.

General Expectations:

- Serve as a positive representative of the University.
- Maintain confidentiality in communication, decision-making, and other program processes.
- Assist in the recruitment and registration of T3 mentees.
- Mentor a group of 1 to 5 first-year T3 mentees.
- Promote T3 by participating in events sponsored by Campus Connections, Experience LSU and Office of Admissions as needed.
- Serve as a positive role model to other mentors and mentees.
- Abide by and enforce all T3 and University rules and regulations.
- Complete end of the semester peer mentor and program evaluation.
- Assist with other duties as assigned.

Overall Responsibilities:

- Complete required training including Campus Connections Leadership Summit (**February 23rd - 24th**), T3 in person training (**August 17th**), and peer mentor online Moodle training.
- Attend and participate in all peer mentor monthly meetings.
- Attend and facilitate small group discussions in collaboration with 2-4 other peer mentors for all T3 small group monthly meetings/events, including T3 Leave Your MARK (Motivating And Relaying Knowledge) Project.
- Attend and participate in all T3 signature events and activities including, but not limited to: T3 Kick Off (**August 19th**), Academic Success Workshop (**September 13th**), Trivia Challenge (**October 23rd**), and Holiday Fest (**November 14th**).
- Support and participate in other Campus Connection initiatives including, but not limited to: What's the Big Deal about Jambalaya, Fall Harvest, and Seaux Stressed, as needed.
- Inform and encourage mentee participation of designated T3 Programs, recommended programs/events that support academic, social, and personal development.
- Be active in the online moodle community for mentees through responding to discussion posts and participating in the various forums.
- Conduct at least 4 (one per month: August, September, October, November) in person meetings with your mentee(s) during the fall semester and submit monthly documentation forms (September, October, November) via Moodle following each meeting.
