### **GLOBAL E<sup>3</sup> EXCHANGES**

Global E<sup>3</sup> is a group of universities that host students studying engineering abroad. Highly regarded as some of the best universities for engineering programs, this consortium allows students to study for a semester or a year in a foreign country while paying LSU tuition. After the program, some universities offer internships to their students to further enrich their experience.

#### **BILATERAL EXCHANGES**

Bilateral Exchanges are orchestrated through a direct agreement between LSU and the host university. These arrangements have been specifically established to coordinate and enhance the LSU engineering program. This program also allows you to spend a semester or academic year abroad while still paying LSU tuition.
