2022-2023 STUDENT SPOUSE LETTER OF NONFILING

Your 2022-2023 application for federal student aid has been selected for verification. Your spouse indicated on the FAFSA that they "will not file" a 2020 federal income tax return. If this information is correct, our office is required to verify that a federal income tax return was not filed with Internal Revenue Service (IRS). Failure to submit the required document(s) will result in a delay in the processing of your aid. The student's name and LSU ID should be listed on all documents submitted.

- Submit a 2020 IRS Letter of Nonfiling dated after October 1, 2021 or later
- May be requested online at irs.gov under "Get Your Tax Record"
- The online tool requires a two-step verification. You will need the following:
 - your SSN and date of birth
 - access to your email account
 - your personal account number from a credit card, mortgage, home equity loan, home equity line of credit or car loan, and
 - a mobile phone with your name on the account.
- Or by completing a 'Request for Transcript of Tax Return' IRS form 4506-T
 - Verifying that item 7 is selected and the year or period requested is 12/31/2020.
