	29	<b>Thesis and Dissertation Uploading deadline.</b> All theses and dissertations of the current semester’s graduates must be <b>committee approved and uploaded</b> to the Graduate School’s Digital Commons site by 4:30 p.m. In addition, all degree requirements must be met: final defense reports, document approval forms, Survey of Earned Doctorates completion certificates, and Declaration of Co-Authors (if applicable) forms must be received by the Graduate School on or before this date. <b>Dissertation Title Deadline:</b> Any changes to dissertation titles turned in after this date will <i>not</i> be reflected in the commencement guide at graduation.
