This examination will consist of questions taken from graduate and undergraduate organic chemistry exams that I have given over the past 25 years. There is nothing you can do specifically to prepare for this examination. Questions will draw on *your cumulative knowledge in the field of organic chemistry* and may expect you to do some of the following:

- Propose structures for intermediates and products;
- Suggest reagents and protecting groups to effect transformations;
- Rationalize the stereochemical outcome of reactions;
- Propose mechanisms for transformations;
- Discuss/intepret physical data (*e.g.*, NMR spectra, m.p.)
